BISQUIER WINS GREAT PLAINS TMT AT LUBBOCK

Mark Smith organized this event which attracted 47 players to the Pioneer Hotel. E. B. Edmondson directed the tournament. New York Master, Arthur Bisquier scored $5\frac{1}{2}$ and won First Place the easy way, by drawing the last round game with Roy Oster. Gary Simms defeated former Texas Champion, John Hall, and split the Second and Third Prizes with Roy Oster and Eric Bone from Houston, as each scored 5-1. We hope to receive a report on who won the Class Prizes, and a complete cross-table for publication in the next issue of TEXAS KNIGHTS.

JAMES STALLINGS SCORES BIG IN BIG "D"

There were 76 players in the big parade, the 5th of July weekend chess tmt at Dallas. The battle scared veteran, James Stallings took undisputed First with a perfect 5-0. Ron Larsen of Oklahoma, and Lewis McClary scored $4\frac{1}{2}$ points each, and divided the 2nd and Third! Place prizes equally. Master John Jacobs tied with Charles Floto and many others with equal scores of 4-1. The readers will probably see the complete cross table soon. Once again, James Campion has directed a financially successful event. What I mean, is... the Dallas Chess Club did not lose any money. Wonderful, Wonderful.

UNFAIR PRIZE DISTRIBUTION

Because there was a Reserved for Class A prize (Wrongful), and his entry fee was used as part of this fund (Unfair!), and because the Fourth Place prize was less than the Class prizes (Unjust), a Master, Jacobs did not receive his rightful equal share of prize money. Floto, with the same score of 4 points, was given more money.

BRIEGER WINS PAUL MORPHY OPEN

Frank RePass was upset in his early round game with Class B rated Jesse Tuggle. Brieger was held to a draw by Class C player, James Mack. Tuggle was polishing off higher rated players right and left! It looked as if Jesse & James might win the tournament. However Mack was knifed by the Houston Junior Champion, Irvin Davidson. Tuggle lost the struggle in the last round game when he blundered to Brieger. RePass played an un-inspired last round draw and scored $5\frac{1}{2}$ - $1\frac{1}{2}$. Robert Brieger, with a $5\frac{1}{2}$ score also (including three draws) won the First Place trophy on tie-breaking points. Four players tied for Third Prize with 5-2. They were: Class A winners, Spencer Hurd and Frank Chavez. Class B winners, E. T. C. Lewis and J. Tuggle. (of Houston) W. Jones (Texas) won Best Class C with 4-3. Charles Turner won Best Class D. Michael Owens was the highest Unrated player with $3\frac{1}{2}$ - $3\frac{1}{2}$. Warren Porter did a fine job of directing this 3 day tournament. Floto argued that Jacobs deserves less, because the Master "did not finish as high as he was expected to." Imagine a horse race in which a money prize is given the owner of the Fourth horse which was expected to finish last; while denying the 2nd Place prize for the better horse, because he was expected to win the race. When are chess players going to insist that merit prizes be given; those are based strictly on performance, and not on expectation?
